

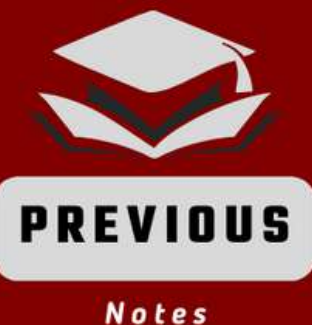

- **Established:** 1981
- **Area:** Approx. 4,400 sq km – largest national park in India
- Highest density of Snow Leopards in the world
- is the **largest national park in the country**
- **400>Snow Leopards. (Total ~ 718 approx. in India)**
- Altitude range: 3,300 – 6,000 m approx
- named after the famous Hemis Monastery located within its boundaries

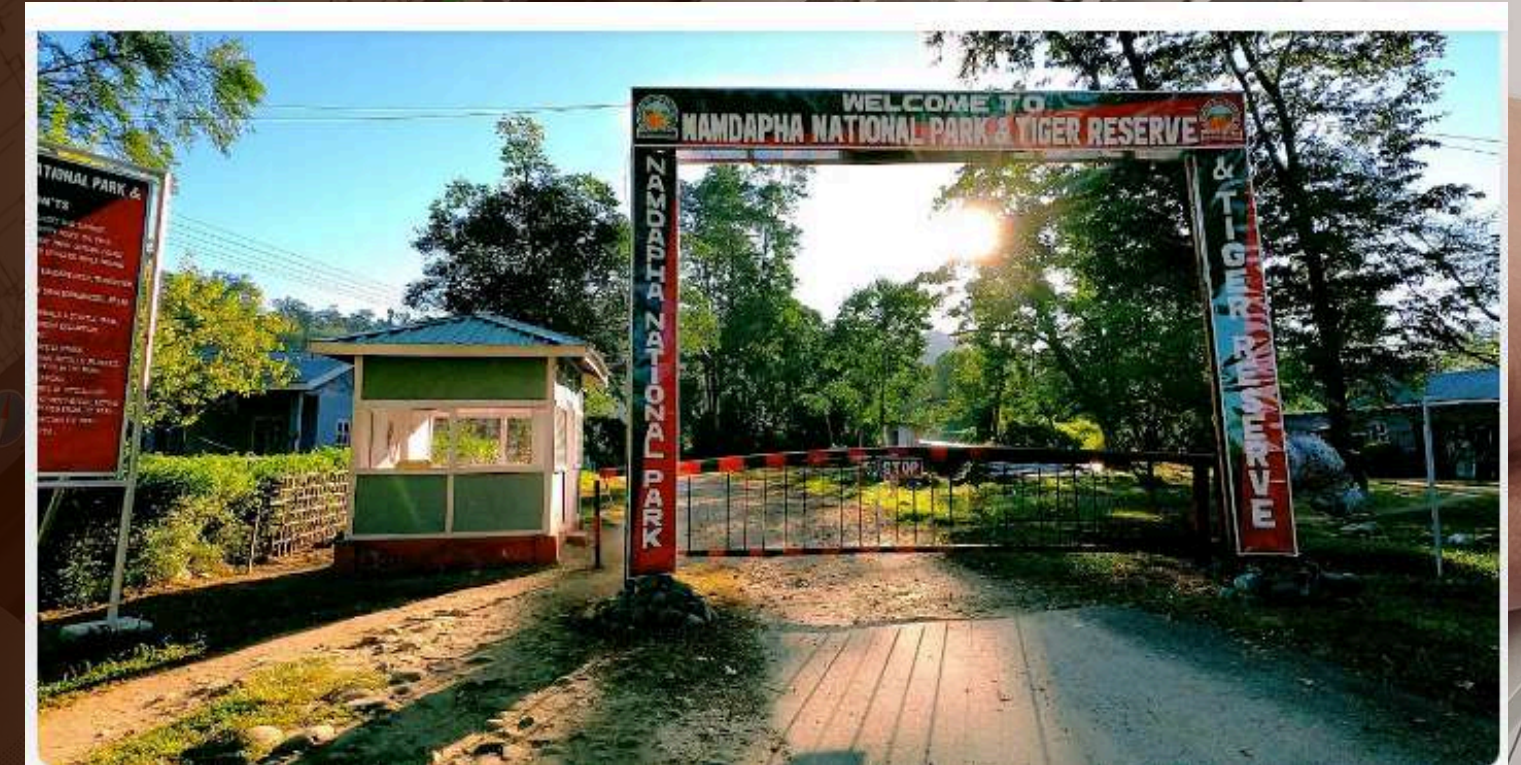

- **Location:** Changlang district, Arunachal Pradesh, India
- **Established:** Declared a Wildlife Sanctuary in 1972, upgraded to a National Park in 1983
- **Area:** Around 1,985 sq km – largest protected area in the Eastern Himalayas and **fourth-largest National Park in India** by area
- The first three are Hemis National Park in Ladakh, Desert National Park in Rajasthan, and Gangotri National Park in Uttarakhand.
- **Altitude Range:** From 200 m to 4,500 m, covering tropical to alpine ecosystems
- It is also on the **Tentative Lists of UNESCO World Heritage Sites** in India.

- **Location: Sikkim, India**
- **Established: 1977**
- **Area: 1,784 sq km**
- **Altitude Range: 1,829 m to 8,586 m (includes Mount Khangchendzonga, the 3rd highest peak in the world)**
- **Designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2016**
- **Sacred landscape for local communities, especially in Tibetan Buddhist traditions**
- **Believed to be the abode of the guardian deity of Sikkim – Dzonga**

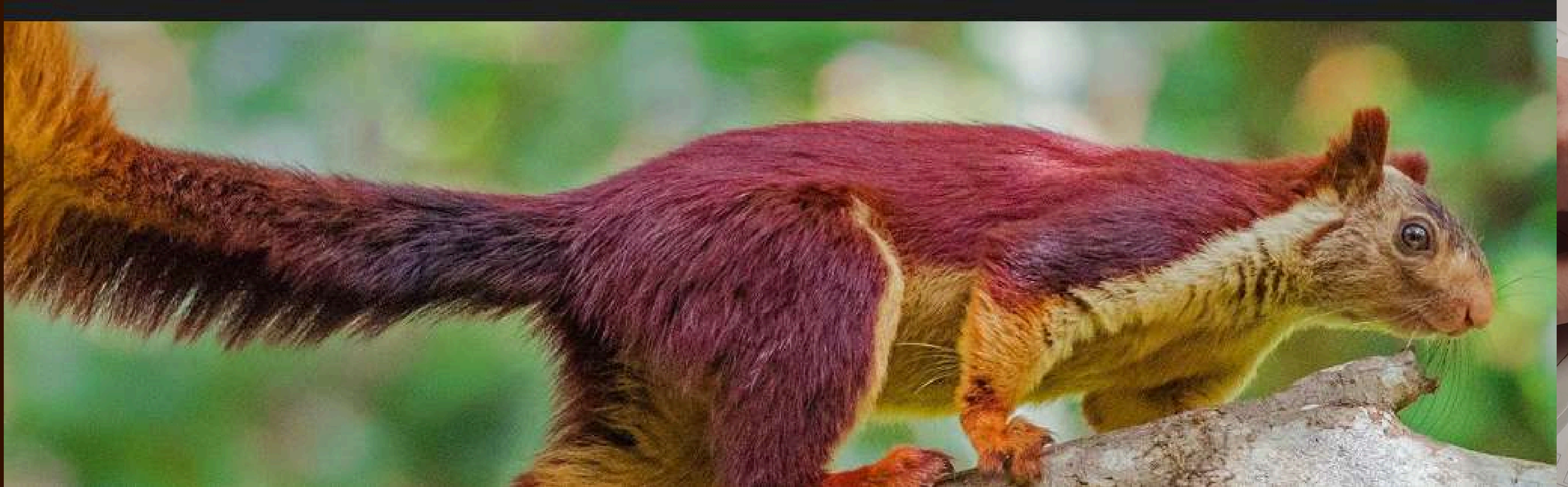

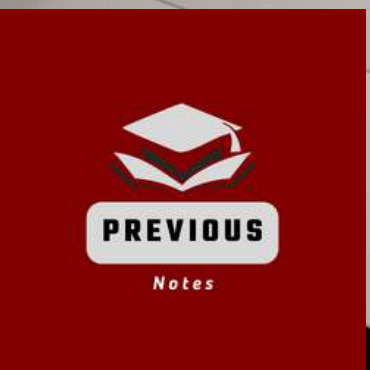

- **Established:** Declared a reserve forest in 1905, a wildlife sanctuary in 1950, and a national park in 1974
- **UNESCO World Heritage Site:** Since 1985
- **Famous For:**
- **Largest population of the Indian One-Horned Rhinoceros in the world** Also home to tigers, elephants, wild buffalo, and swamp deer (part of the “Big Five” of Kaziranga)
- **Area:** Approx. 1,090 sq km
- **Rivers:** Located on the floodplains of the Brahmaputra River; frequent seasonal flooding rejuvenates the grasslands

- **Union Territory:** Jammu and Kashmir
- Located about 22 km from Srinagar, **Srinagar Dist.**
- **Area:** 141 sq km
- Dachigam National park is located in the **Zabarwan Range** of the western Himalayas.
- Altitude ranges from 1,700 to 4,300 meters, providing diverse climatic zones
- **Name “Dachigam” means "ten villages", representing ten villages** relocated for its formation.

Declared a National Park in 1981.

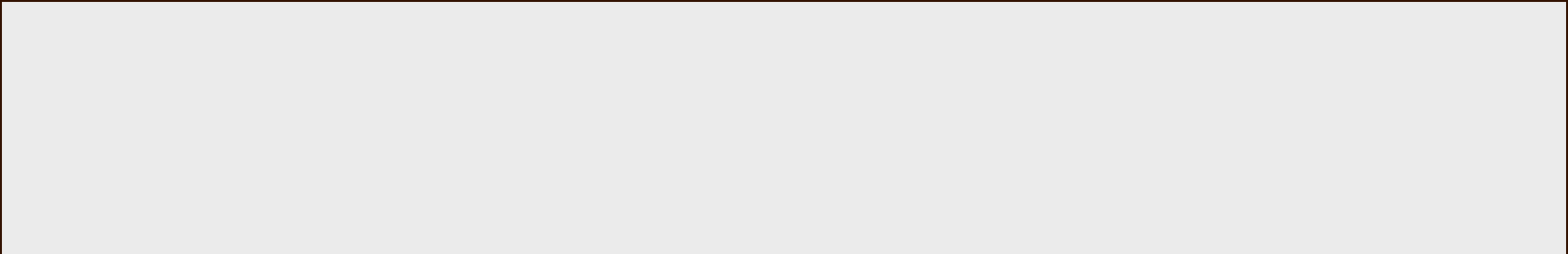
